**NINE MONTHS 2019 SALES**

**The Board of Directors has examined the Consolidated Net Sales of Nine Months 2019**

**Consolidated net sales € 674.4 ml (+9.1% vs € 618.0 ml of 3Q 2018)**

These are the highlights of the sales of the first nine months of 2019 examined earlier today by the Board of Directors of SOL S.p.A., a listed company on the Italian Stock Exchange that acts as holding company to a multinational group with more than 4,300 employees, involved in the businesses of technical gases and home-care assistance, operating in Europe, in Turkey, in Morocco, in India and in Brasil.

In a context characterized by a slowing economic situation in Italy and Europe, in the nine months of 2019 Sol Group achieved a growth of 9.1 % in sales volume compared with the same period of 2018 (5.8% at the same perimeter).

The positive result is due to the sales in Italy, amounting to € 292.6 with an increase of 2.9%, and abroad, equal to € 381.7, where the growth was of 14.4%.

With reference to the two businesses of the Group, the sales of the Technical Gases Division were € 309.5 with a growth of 2.3%, whereas the sales of the Home Care Division, in which the Group operates through VIVISOL, were € 364.8 and marked a growth of 15.7%.

*“We consider in a positive way the results achieved in the first nine months of 2019”* affirmed Marco Annoni, Vice-President of SOL S.p.A. *“which confirm the capability of development of SOL Group also in a worse economic situation than in 2018 “.*

*“In the year 2019”,* concluded SOL Chairman Aldo Fumagalli Romario, *“our target is to confirm the growth of sales, continuing the investment program sustaining the development, the diversification and the innovation of Sol Group”.*
