In particular, with the adoption of the Energy Management System group companies reaffirm their willingness to:

- Acquire full knowledge of the energy consumption of their activities;
- Monitor and reduce their energy requirements per unit of output;
- Ensure compliance with legislative and regulatory requirements;
- Ensure compliance of their behavior to adopted energy policy;
- Be able to demonstrate such compliance to third parties
- Increase and maintain high motivation of staff in the implementation of plans to improve energy efficiency.

To achieve these objectives, the SOL Group companies are committed to:


- Work with an energy policy that is documented, implemented, maintained and communicated to all staff;


